**FULL TEXT OF THE PROPOSED REGULATION AMENDMENT:**

**~~6C7-UCF-2.0031~~ Post-baccalaureate Non-degree Students.**

A student with a baccalaureate degree or equivalent may seek admission as a post-baccalaureate non-degree student. Admission of post-baccalaureate non-degree students shall be on a selective basis within curricular, space and fiscal limitations. The selections shall be based on academic records, educational objectives, career objectives, and need for continuing educational

opportunities. ~~This category will accommodate (1) school teachers seeking recertification and (2) employees of area industries as documented by the employer.~~ In order to continue, students who are given temporary acceptance in the post-baccalaureate category must submit, by the end of the first term, an official transcript which indicates a bachelor's degree or equivalent. Failure to do so will lead to cancellation of any further registration as a post-baccalaureate student.
